

Recognised Healthy Workplace Criteria Summary



The level of Recognition a workplace achieves (Bronze, Silver or Gold) will depend on the longevity and comprehensiveness of the workplace health and wellbeing program.

Mandatory items for all applications include:

- Support from Senior Management;
- Staff consultation;
- A dedicated Program Coordinator who has undertaken [HWWA Coordinator Training](#) (either face-to-face or online) within the last two years; and
- An [Action Plan](#) implemented for a minimum of 6 months.

Assessment requirements for Gold, Silver and Bronze are:

Length of time Action Plan has been implemented (longevity of program)	24 months or more	18 to 24 months	6 to 18 months
Comprehensiveness - how many SNAP lifestyle risk factors are addressed	All four SNAP	At least two	At least one
Comprehensiveness - how many strategy areas are implemented (health and wellbeing policy; the physical environment; and education and awareness raising activities)	All three	At least two	At least one
Has evaluation been conducted?	Yes	Yes/No	Yes/No
Does your workplace have a designated smoking area?	No	Yes/No	Yes/No
